The 6th Annual Mountain Music School will bring together students of all ages for a week of learning, music, and fun.

Mountain Music School is dedicated to

the preservation and continuation of Appalachian music and culture, offering 'ear training' in beginning

old-time fiddle, claw-hammer banjo, folk guitar, mandolin and dulcimer. A string-band class for intermediate/advanced musicians will be offered if there is enough interest.

Mountain Music School enrolls youth and adults ages 10 and over. The School will open for one week, July 26 - 30, Monday – Friday, and operate from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m., on the Mountain Empire Community College campus in Big Stone Gap, Virginia.

The faculty includes well-known local musicians Todd Meade, Ron Short, and Steve Souther and many others. Students are treated to class visits and afternoon concerts by master musicians. All afternoon concerts are open and free to the general public.

Mountain Music School wraps-up on Fri-

day afternoon, with a celebration and student/instructor concert open to family and friends of students and faculty. All students will receive a Mountain Music School t-shirt.

Tuition is \$150 for both youth and adults and a limited number of "youth scholarships" are available. Scholarships are also available. A limited number of instruments (banjos, fiddles, and guitars) will be loaned to students.
